


Evening: Enjoy free time to explore the local markets of textiles, gems, carpets, and handicrafts.

Evening: Check in at your Ranthambore hotel and relax.


Ranthambore to Udaipur via Chittorgarh


Late Morning: Explore the City Palace, including its museum with its exquisite peacock mosaics and miniature paintings.



Evening: Enjoy a casual evening exploring Jaisalmer's local markets or a relaxed dinner.






Jaisalmer Sightseeing and Sam Sand Dunes














Check out from the desert camp and drive to Jodhpur (approximately 4-5 hours).


