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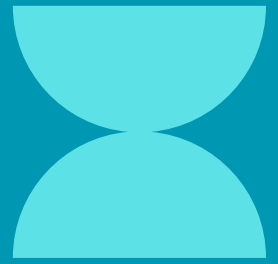
DAY 1

Arrival at Stockholm.

Transfer to your hotel and relax for the day.

DAY 2

- Panoramic tour of the beautiful capital city built on 14 interconnected islands.
- Visit Gamla Stan ("the city between bridges"), featuring:
 - i. Nobel Prize Museum near Stortorget square
 - ii. Cathedral and Royal Palace
- Enjoy stunning views from Fjällgatan viewpoint when possible.
- Leisure time for personal exploration.
- Recommended visits: museums and parks.
- Optional: City Hall and Vasa Museum

DAY 3 STOCKHOLM - OVERNIGHT ON BOARD

- Enjoy beautiful landscapes as the boat departs from Stockholm.
- Night cruise; remember to bring documentation for boarding.
- Luggage: Prepare hand luggage; main luggage stays on the coach.
- Clothing: Bring warm attire for the ferry deck.
- Currency: Finland uses euros; exchange offices available onboard for Swedish Crowns.
- Free Day: Explore Stockholm's historic center and Museums Island.
- 5:00 p.m.: Transfer to the port of Stockholm.
- Ferry Info: Board the modern Silja Lines ferry with amenities like restaurants, bars, nightclub, casino, shops, and spacious rooms.
- Departure: Estimated at 7:30 p.m.; enjoy stunning views of numerous islands from the deck
- Accommodation: Spend the night in double cabins onboard.

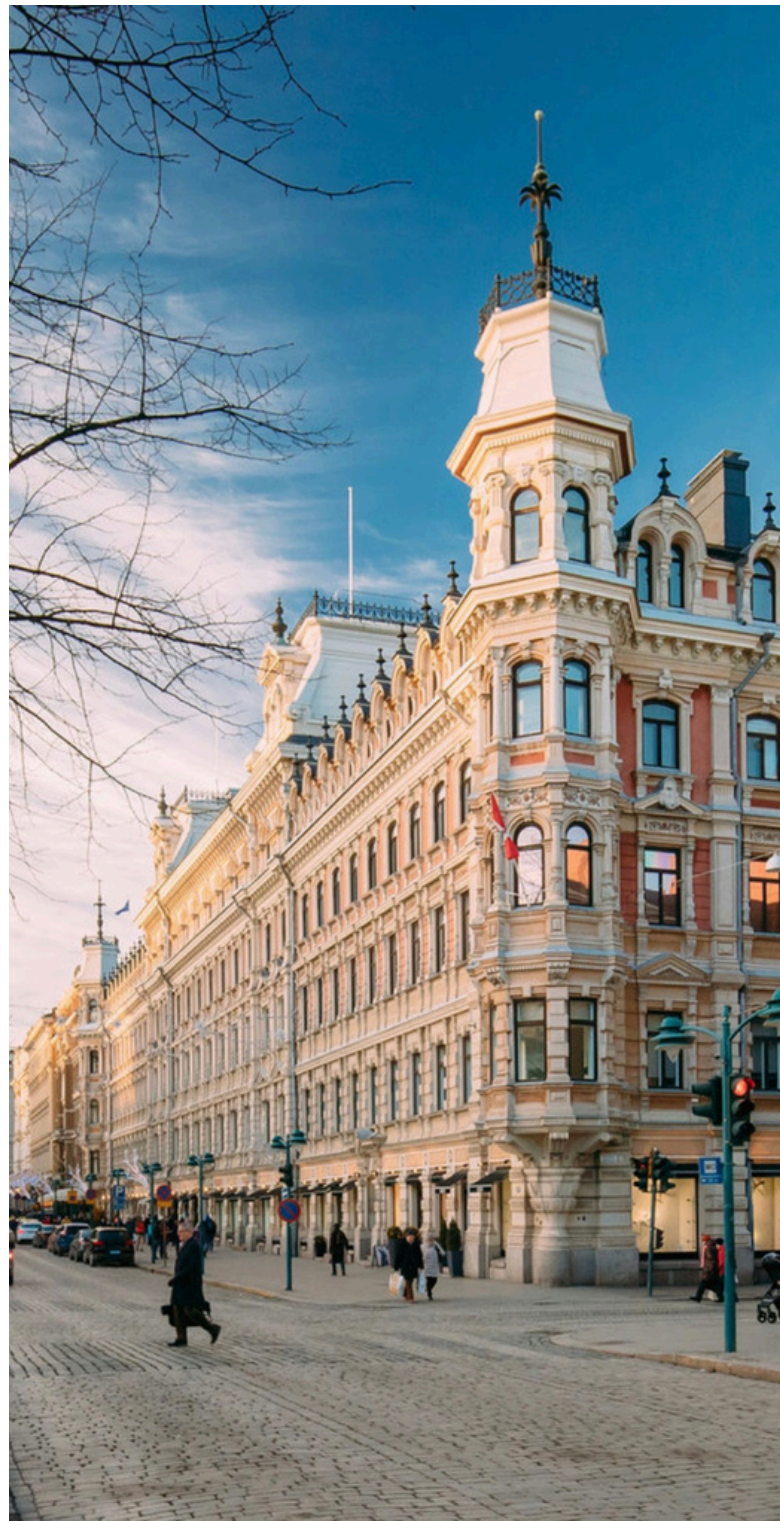


DAY 4

Turku - Naantali - Helsinki

Upon arrival in Finland, you will need to adjust your watch; when it is 12:00 p.m. in Sweden, it is 1:00 p.m. in Finland.

- As we arrive in Finland, we recommend heading to the ship's deck at sunrise to enjoy the mesmerizing landscapes as we sail past the Åland Islands, a series of forest-covered isles. Breakfast is included in your trip.
- 07:30 a.m. - Turku:
 - i. Disembark in Finland's second-largest city with Swedish influence.
 - ii. Free time to explore the city center.
- 08:30 a.m. - Departure from Turku.
- 09:20 a.m. - Naantali:
 - i. Arrive in a picturesque village with wooden houses by the sea.
 - ii. Enjoy time for a stroll.
- 10:45 a.m. - Departure from Naantali.
- 01:00 p.m. - Helsinki:
 - i. Time for lunch and an afternoon of free exploration.
 - ii. Discover the old market and observe Russian influences in buildings and churches.

DAY 5

- 09:00 a.m.: Departure from the hotel
 - Activity: Boat trip to the Suomenlinna Islands on regular line water transport.
 - Description: Archipelago of six islands with a grand fortress, a UNESCO World Heritage site.
 - Free Time: Stroll and cross small pedestrian bridges; guide will provide information on maximizing your visit.
 - Return Ticket: Flexible stay duration in the archipelago.
 - Ferry to Estonia:
- Departure: 3:30 p.m.; ferry trip lasts approximately 2 hours and 30 minutes.
- Recommendation: Enjoy views of Helsinki and surrounding islands during the sail.
- 5:45 p.m.: Arrival in Tallinn; check into your accommodation.



TALLINN, ESTONIA

DAY 6



- 09:00 a.m.: Sightseeing tour of Tallinn, Estonia's captivating capital.
- Highlights: Explore the well-preserved medieval center, including:
 - i. Ancient walls
 - ii. Historic churches
 - iii. Charming squares
 - iv. Picturesque streets with attractions.
- Afternoon: Free time to explore Tallinn at your leisure.

DAY 7

TALLINN - PÄRNU - TURAIDA - SIGULDA - SALASPILS - RIGA

- 08:00 a.m.: Departure from Tallinn, traveling through forests and plains.
- 10:00 a.m.: Arrive in Parnu: Popular spa city; stop for coffee in the city center.
- 11:00 a.m.: Departure from Parnu; cross the border into Latvia.

i. Short stop near a beach on the Baltic coast.

ii. Continue journey through scenic hills, forests, and Gauja National Park.

iii. Enjoy included lunch at a local restaurant before heading to the nearby castle.

- 02:00 p.m.: Visit Turaida Castle and National Park: Admission included for this impressive medieval fortress and its extensive park.
- 03:30 p.m.: Departure from Turaida.
- 04:00 p.m.: Arrive in Sigulda: Tourist center; free time for a walk.
- 05:00 p.m.: Departure from Sigulda.
- 05:45 p.m.: Visit Salaspils Memorial:

i. Located near Riga; commemorates victims of the Nazi regime

ii. One of the largest monumental complexes in Europe.

- 06:45 p.m.: Departure from Salaspils.
- 08:00 p.m.: Arrival in Riga.
- Note: Visit to Salaspils Memorial may occur on Sunday before arriving in Riga or on Tuesday when leaving the city, depending on daylight hours.

DAY 8



- City Tour: Two-hour tour of Riga, the capital of Latvia and the most populous city in the Baltic states.
- Highlights:
 - i. Renowned cultural center
 - ii. Medieval Historic Center
 - iii. Art Nouveau architecture
 - iv. Well-preserved remnants from the Soviet era
- Afternoon: Free time to explore Riga at your leisure.





DAY 9



- 08:30 a.m.: Departure from Riga; journey through Latvia's vast plains.
- 10:00 a.m.: Arrive at Rundale Palace: Tickets included to explore this grand palace and its gardens, built during the same era as St. Petersburg.
- 11:15 a.m.: Departure from Rundale Palace; continue to Lithuania, rich in Catholic heritage.
- 12:15 p.m.: Visit Kryziu Kalnas (Hill of Crosses): A remarkable site adorned with thousands of crosses, symbolizing Lithuania's Catholic legacy post-Soviet oppression.
- 01:00 p.m.: Departure from Kryziu Kalnas; travel through central Lithuania, passing industrial regions and farmlands.
- 05:00 p.m.: Arrive in Trakai:
 - i. Visit the enchanting castle on an island in the lake; admission included.
 - ii. Located in a quaint village with wooden houses and lush forests.
- 06:30 p.m.: Proceed to the neighboring city of Vilnius.
- 07:00 p.m.: Arrive in Vilnius; recommended to stroll through the beautiful old town.

VILNIUS, LITHUANIA

DAY 10



Morning: Included panoramic tour of Vilnius, partially on foot.

Highlights :

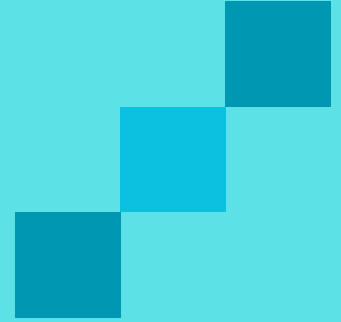
- Built on seven hills, often compared to Rome.
- Explore Baroque churches, ancient walls, and a majestic castle.
- Stroll through lively commercial streets and see 1,200 medieval houses.



Afternoon: Free time to explore Vilnius at your own pace.

DAY 11

Vilnius - Grutas Park - Augustów - Warsaw



- 08:00 a.m.: Departure from Vilnius; travel to Poland.
- 10:00 a.m.: Arrive at Grutas Park ("Stalin's World"): Features 86 statues from Soviet times; admission included.
- 11:30 a.m.: Departure from Grutas Park.
- 12:30 p.m. (1:30 p.m. in Lithuania): Arrive in Augustów: A lively tourist town by a lake; time for lunch.
- 02:30 p.m.: Departure from Augustów; journey through the interior of Poland, passing small villages and agricultural areas.
- 06:30 p.m.: Arrive in Warsaw: Recommended to stroll through the vibrant market square.



- 09:00 a.m.: After breakfast, embark on a two-and-a-half-hour panoramic tour of Warsaw with a local guide.
- Highlights :
 - i. Explore the charming Old Town with 17th and 18th-century structures.
 - ii. See remnants of the medieval wall, St. John's Cathedral, and the Royal Palace.
 - iii. Cobblestone streets carefully rebuilt after World War II, now a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
 - iv. Visit the Palace of Culture, a skyscraper gifted by the Soviet Union.
 - v. Reflect on the history of the largest Jewish ghetto in Europe.
 - vi. Stroll through Lazienki Park, home to the Chopin monument.
- Afternoon: Free time to:
 - = Visit museums such as the National Museum and Warsaw Rising Museum.
 - = Explore the lively city center filled with shops and activities.
