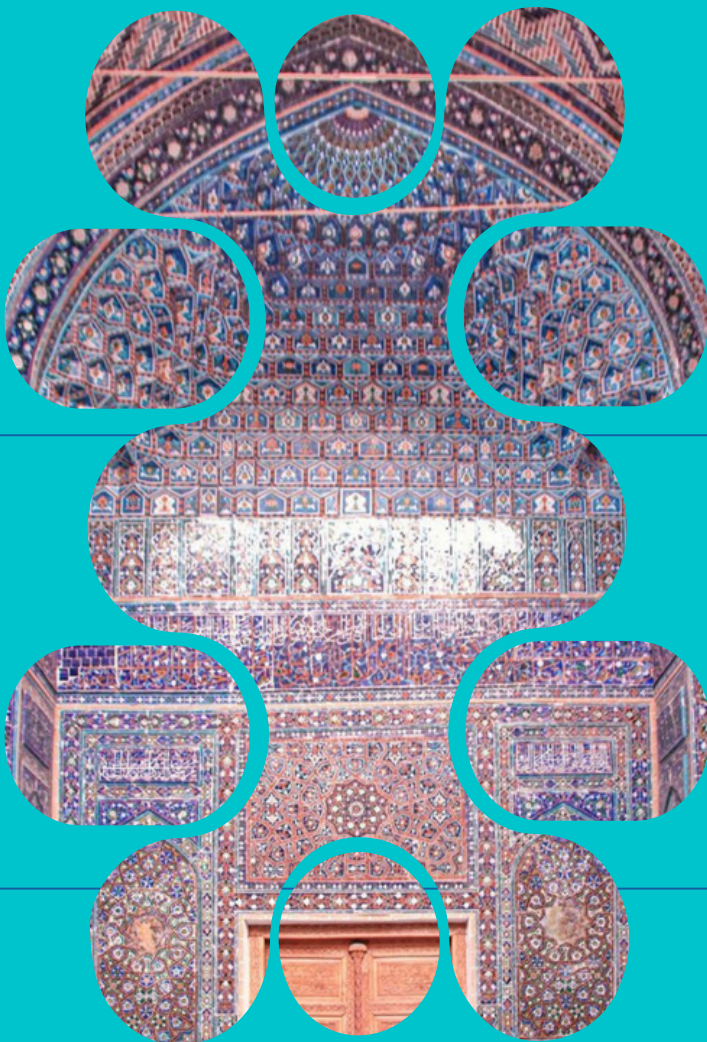

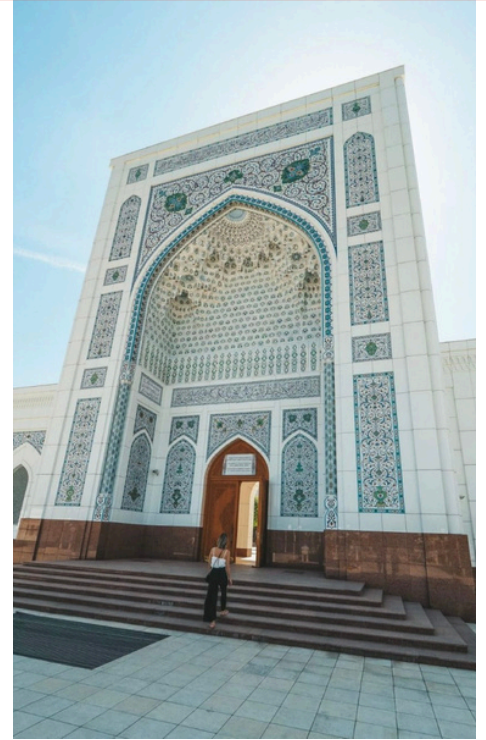
DAY 1

Tashkent – City tour

Khasti Imam Complex (Barak-Khan Madrasah, Tilla-Sheykh Mosque, Mausoleum of Saint Abu Bakr Kaffal Shashi), Construction was an expensive undertaking: sandalwood columns from India, green marble from Turkey and blue tiles from Iran point to the international underpinning given to this visible new bastion of Islam. The primary attraction on Khast Imam stands in the center of the square: the small Muyi Mubarak Library holds the oldest Quran in the world. The Uthman Quran on display is stained with the blood of the third Caliph Uthman who was murdered while reading it in 655. Islamic Institute of Imam al-Bukhari (outside), Amir Timur Square, Independence Square, Amir Timur Museum (outside), White mosque, Tashkent City Magic City Walk tour – Uzbekistan Disneyland Shopping at Samarkand Darvaza Mall and Chorsu Bazaar, the biggest and oldest bazaar in Central Asia.

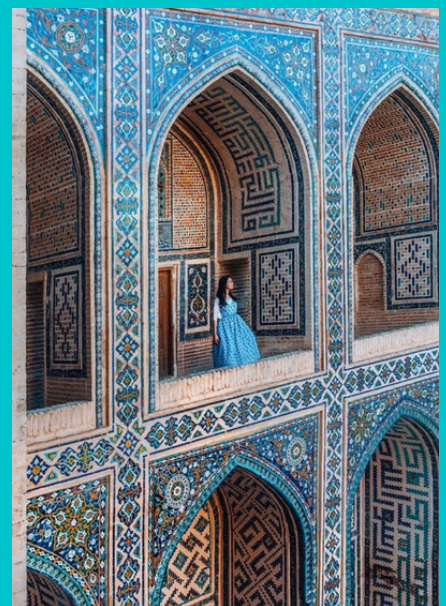
Samarkand city tour: Registan Square with three Madrasahs: “Sherdor” (17th cent.), Tilla Kori” (17th cent.) and “Ulugbek” (15th cent.). One of the most mysterious and unique architectural monuments of Samarkand, Shakhi Zinda complex. It consists of rows of refined sparkling blue colored tombs. Harmoniously combined in a lively and moving composition, various mausoleums are grouped along the narrow medieval streets. Shakhi Zinda consists of eleven mausoleums, which were built one after another in 14 - 15th centuries. Continue by shopping at local Siab Bazar.



Silk Road Samarkand Tourist Complex

Silk Road Samarkand is a modern multiplex which is set to open in early 2022 in eastern Samarkand. The complex covers 260 hectares and includes world-class business and medical hotels, eateries, recreational facilities, park grounds, an ethnographic corner. For centuries, Samarkand was among the most renowned cities on the Great Silk Road, attracting merchants, travelers and adventurers from far and wide. A central feature of Silk Road Samarkand is the 2-kilometer-long channel which divides the complex into northern and southern sections. The water brings a cool freshness to the desert climate while beautifully mirroring the surrounding structures. This artificial channel has served as a training base for Uzbekistan's athletic rowing crews for decades and will retain this function in the new tourist center so that guests can watch the canoes and kayaks as they pass by.

Southern side also includes: Eternal City, a historical and ethnographic project with craft workshops, quaint streets, small shops and other features of a traditional eastern city.

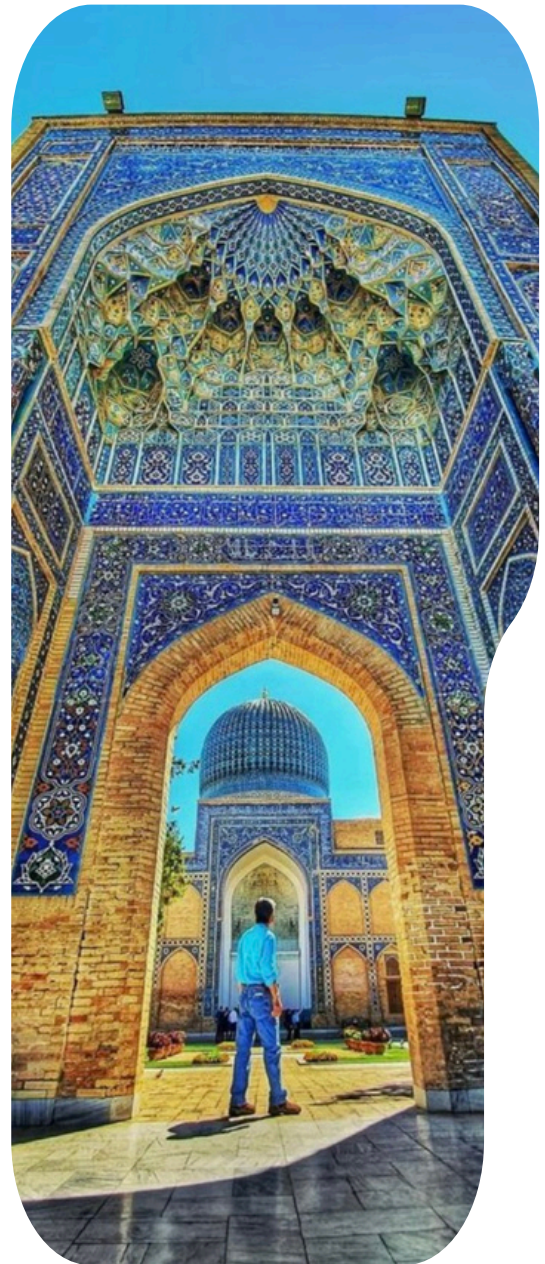
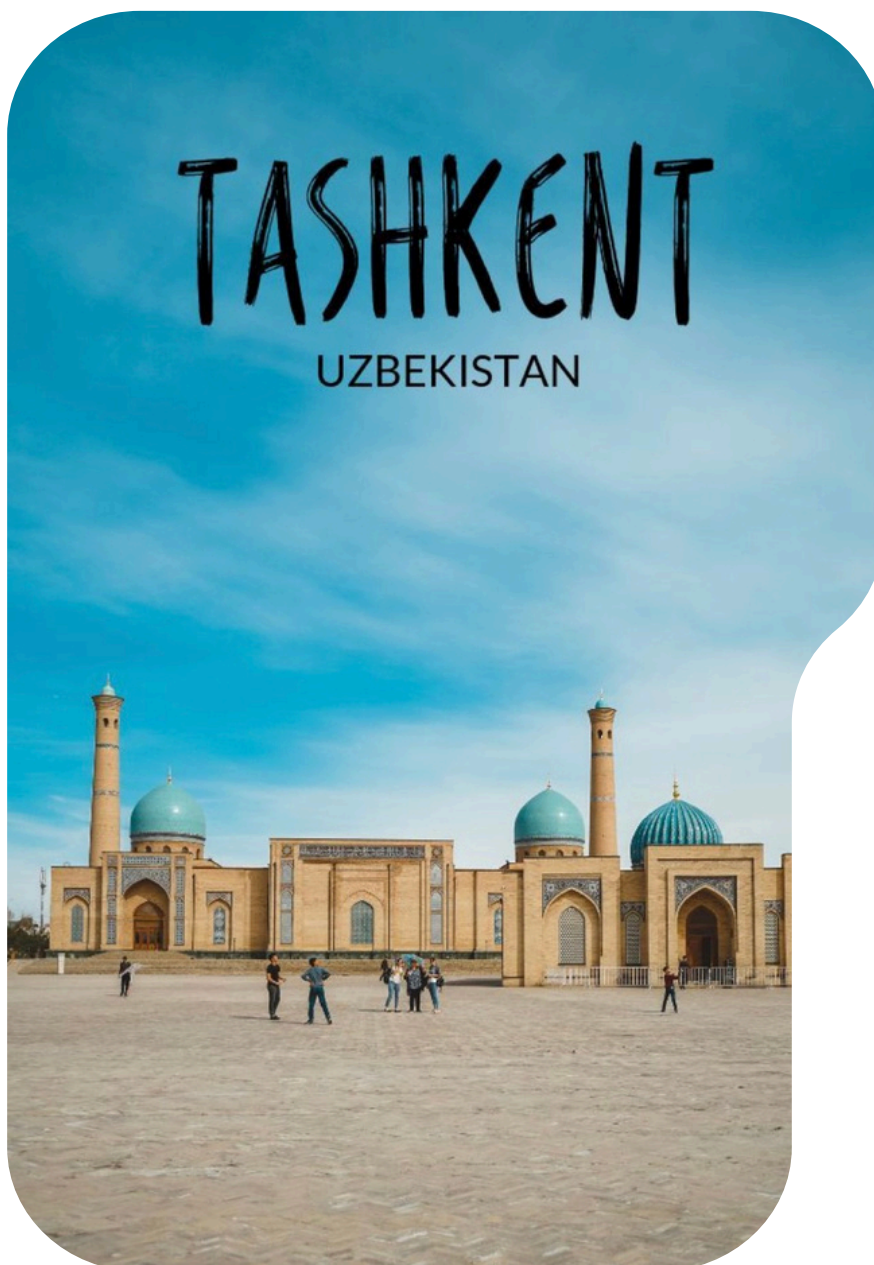
ABOUT ARK FORTRESS

The fortress of the Ark, around which the city of Bukhara arose, has survived to this day, although it has been rebuilt many times over several centuries. It is located on a raised embankment, the height of which reaches 20 meters, and the area of the fortress is 4.2 hectares. Initially, the fortress was a closed polygon, and its steep slopes were completely lined with blocks. Before the arrival of the Arabs to the lands of Bukhara, the Ark fortress served as the seat of the Bukhara rulers. During the reign of the Karakhanid dynasty and during the invasion of Genghis Khan, the fortress was repeatedly destroyed. And only in the XVI century, under the rule of the Sheibanid dynasty, the Ark took its final form.
