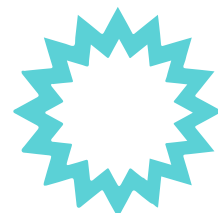

From DAY 2 the tour begins





- 08:00 a.m. – Departure from Rome – Heading towards the Adriatic Sea
 - 12:00 p.m. – Visit to S. Giovanni in Venere Abbey (Built on the ruins of an ancient Roman temple dedicated to Venus)
 - 12:45 p.m. – Departure from S. Giovanni in Venere Abbey
 - 01:45 p.m. – Arrival in Termoli
- i. Seaside town with a walled old quarter
 - ii. 13th-century castle and Romanesque cathedral
 - iii. Time for lunch and a stroll, optional swim in the sea
- 03:30 p.m. – Departure from Termoli
 - 05:30 p.m. – Arrival in Trani, Known as "the Pearl of the Adriatic", Famous for its pink Romanesque cathedral
 - 06:30 p.m. – Departure from Trani
 - 07:30 p.m. – Arrival in Bari – Norman castle, a symbol of Apulia
 - 08:30 p.m. – Transfer to the hotel

DAY 3



- After breakfast – Free time to explore the old town of Bari
- 10:00 a.m. – Departure from Bari
- 11:30 a.m. – Arrival in Brindisi (Continuing along the Adriatic Sea coast).
- Time to explore: stroll by the sea, see the Roman column, and wander the charming old quarter
- 01:00 p.m. – Departure from Brindisi
- Time for a walk and lunch
- 04:00 p.m. – Departure from Lecce
- 05:30 p.m. – Arrival in Taranto - Visit the Castello Aragonese, old quarter, and cathedral
- 07:00 p.m. – Departure from Taranto
- 08:00 p.m. – Return to the hotel in Brindisi



DAY 4



- 09:00 a.m. – Departure from Brindisi
- 10:15 a.m. – Arrival in Alberobello (UNESCO World Heritage Site)- Remarkable example of Italian rural architecture.
- 11:15 a.m. – Departure from Alberobello - Heading into the Basilicata region
- 01:00 p.m. – Arrival in Matera - Renowned for its ancient historic center and Sassi di Matera. Ancient dwellings carved into the rock, dating back thousands of years. It is UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- 03:30 p.m. – Departure from Matera
- Continuing through Basilicata and Campania, enjoying mountain landscapes
- 07:00 p.m. – Arrival in Naples
- Evening arrival, with time to take a stroll through the city
- Stay at Naples.





DAY 5

- 09:30 a.m. – Departure from Naples by ferry
- Boat trip lasts about 1 hour with picturesque views
- 10:40 a.m. – Arrival in Capri
- Free time for lunch on the island
- Optional activities :

i. Take a boat to visit Grotta Bianca and the Faraglioni

ii. Take the funicular to Capri city

- 03:15 p.m. – Ferry to Sorrento
- Enjoying beautiful scenery along the way (ferry schedule may vary)
- 04:00 p.m. – Arrival in Sorrento – Explore this charming town perched on a cliff, Visit the port located in the lower area.
- 06:00 p.m. – Departure from Sorrento
- 07:45 p.m. – Arrival in Salerno – Accommodation and free time for a stroll through this vibrant city
- Note: Winter schedules may vary (earlier departure from Naples) to maximize daylight.



DAY 6

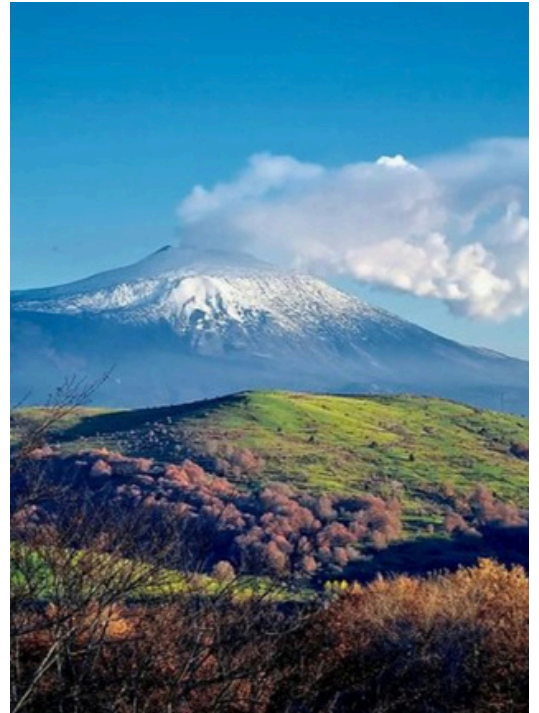
- 07:30 a.m. – Departure from Salerno - Heading towards the picturesque Tyrrhenian Sea coast
- 11:30 a.m. – Arrival at the Sanctuary of St. Francis of Paola
- Time for lunch in the picturesque town
- 02:00 p.m. – Departure from Paola
- Continue to Villa San Giovanni for a short 20-minute ferry crossing to Sicily
- 05:30 p.m. – Arrival in Messina- Time to wander around the city center
- 06:30 p.m. – Departure from Messina
- 07:30 p.m. – Arrival in Taormina



Note: On some days, the included lunch may be substituted with dinner upon arrival in Taormina.



DAY 7



- Taormina – Free Day
 - > Enchanting coastal city at the foot of Mount Etna
 - > Described by Winston Churchill as the most beautiful place on earth
 - Things to do:
 - i. Stroll through the vibrant historic quarter
 - ii. Visit the Greek Theatre with breathtaking views
 - iii. Relax on the beaches
 - Lunch and dinner will be included

Note: In some cases, the included lunch for this day may be replaced with dinner upon arrival in Taormina the previous night.

DAY 8



- 08:30 a.m. – Departure from Taormina, Traveling through beautiful Mediterranean landscapes
- 10:30 a.m. – Arrival in Syracuse
- Guided tour of the city, once rivaling Athens and Rome in power
- Visit the impressive archaeological site
- Explore the well-preserved historic center
- Break for lunch
- 02:00 p.m. – Departure from Syracuse
- 02:45 p.m. – Arrival in Noto – Guided walk through this baroque city, Explore its magnificently preserved monumental heritage and historic center
- 04:30 p.m. – Departure from Noto
- Scenic drive through the island's interior
- 08:00 p.m. – Arrival in Agrigento
- Admire the magnificent Valley of the Temples from the coach
- Dinner will be included



DAY 9



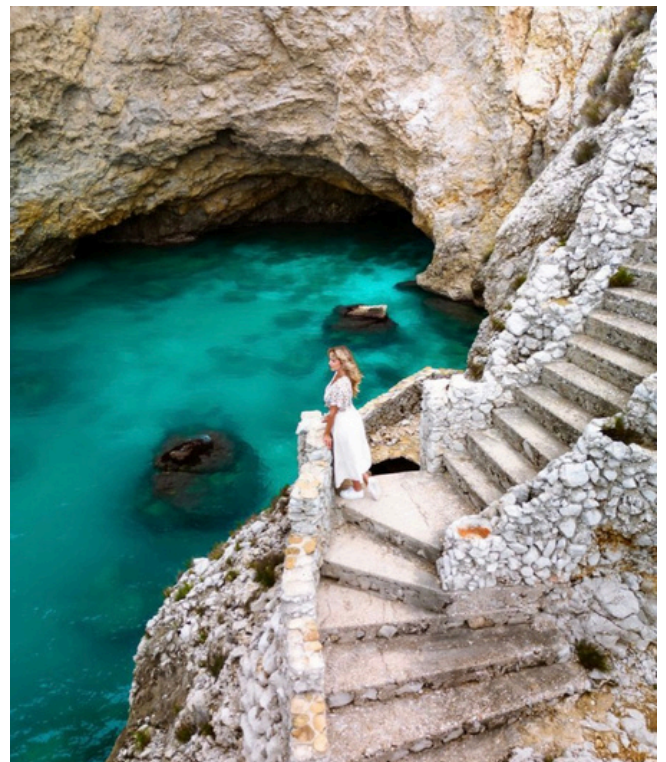
Morning:

- Explore archaeological sites showcasing ancient Greek influence in Sicily
- Visit the Valley of the Temples in Agrigento
- 11:00 a.m. – Departure from Agrigento
- 01:30 p.m. – Arrival in Marsala - Historic city known for its vibrant atmosphere and famous wine & Time for lunch
- 03:00 p.m. – Departure from Marsala - Continue journey around the scenic Marsala salt pans
- 04:15 p.m. – Arrival in Erice (Picturesque Phoenician town perched atop a hill)
- 05:15 p.m. – Departure from Erice
- 07:15 p.m. – Arrival in Palermo
- Dinner and accommodation

- 09:00 a.m. – Guided tour of Palermo
- Visit Monreale :
 - > Explore the Arab-Norman cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site
 - > Admire the magnificent golden mosaics (tickets included)
- Return to Palermo – Visit the Palermo Cathedral, known for its eclectic architecture and royal tombs (tickets included) and Explore the Norman Palace (former Royal Palace), including its fountains, markets, and gardens.
- Panoramic tour concludes at Teatro Massimo Square
- Free time for lunch and a leisurely stroll
- 06:00 p.m. – Transfer to the port
- Board a modern night ferry, departure at 08:00 p.m.
- Accommodation in double cabins with private bathrooms (breakfast not included)
- Ferry equipped with modern comforts: restaurants, bars, banquet hall, and spacious lounges

- Note: Ferry schedules may change due to weather conditions, and an alternate ferry may be used.

These changes may be communicated on short notice and could affect Sunday services.



DAY 11

- 07:30 a.m. – Arrival at the Port of Naples. Disembark and depart for Pompeii. Explore the ancient Roman city buried by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius 2,000 years ago. Guided tour and admission included to learn about the history of this remarkable site
- 11:30 a.m. – Departure from Pompeii
- 12:00 p.m. – Arrival in Naples
- Visit Naples, one of the oldest cities in Europe and a UNESCO World Heritage Site
- Time for lunch
- 02:30 p.m. – Departure from Naples
- 04:00 p.m. – Arrival in Cassino – Visit the Polish Cemetery, commemorating the largest battle fought on Italian soil during WWII.
- Explore the Abbey of Montecassino, enjoying its magnificent views
- 05:30 p.m. – Departure from Cassino
- 08:15 p.m. – Arrival in Rome



DAY 12

After breakfast, we will head for a Rome city tour which will include :

- Hop-on-hop-off bus tour with entry ticket to Sistine Chapel.
- Visit Colosseum
- Stay at Rome for the rest of the day.



DAY 13

After breakfast, our journey will come to an end, leaving you with wonderful lasting memories.
